## Individualized Student Remote Learning Plan

*Governor Baker's Order to close schools through May 3, 2020 prevents in-person instruction at this time. During this period of closure, your child is entitled to receive accommodations and services set forth on his/her/their IEP consistent with the need to protect the health and safety of our students and staff. The School's provision of special education to your student will look different during this unprecedented period of nation and state public health emergency. *In alignment with guidance and recommendations from the Commissioner and DESE, the recommended plan for your student:*

- Focuses on maintaining a connection with and supporting the well being, safety, and ongoing education of your student*
- Ensures meaningful and productive learning opportunities are provided*
- Supports and reinforce developing academic skills and progress on IEP goals*
- Provides a variety of means for engagement, on and off line, including video conferencing, phone, paper, and digital Classroom tools, and small group and individual sessions*
- Exceeds the DESE time recommendation of half a day of school engagement*
- Ensure regular outreach to families to obtain feedback and provide support*
- Encourages participation and engagement in classes; DESE guidance has confirmed that all remote learning is credit bearing and will be reported on at scheduled report card time.*

*Below you will find an individualized Remote Learning Plan for your child. The Remote Learning Plan consists of program email contact information, a schedule of support and contact, and a weekly student schedule for student enrichment and recommended resources for you to utilize during the school closure. It is important to note that this plan is not an IEP amendment. This document is a working document; as we continue to develop our remote learning systems and opportunities, this plan will be adjusted accordingly and as needed for your child. Your feedback and input is essential!*

*Please note, during this period of remote learning, the School's Acceptable Use Policy, Bullying/Cyberbullying Prevention Policy, Student Handbook expectations and Code of Conduct remain in effect. The School has also issued this [guidance](#) specific to remote learning sessions; remote learning does not allow the School to control who is viewing a lesson, and therefore parents and students should be aware that there is no expectation of privacy. Additionally, recording of remote sessions is prohibited.*
